

COMPLAINTS ABOUT POLICIES

Complaints regarding the policies of the Board of Education shall be submitted to the Superintendent of Schools. Complaints shall be in writing and state the specific objection(s) to the specific policy.

The Superintendent shall review, in cooperation with the Policy Committee, any complaint and conduct an appropriate investigation. The Superintendent shall then submit the complaint and his/her recommendation to the Board. The Board shall review the policy and uphold, amend, or repeal the policy, as it deems appropriate. The Board shall then notify the complainant in writing of the action taken.

Appeals from the Board's decision must be made within thirty (30) days to the Commissioner of Education.
