

SMOKING OR THE USE OF ELECTRONIC SMOKING DEVICES
ON SCHOOL PROPERTY

Due to the health hazards and potential risks associated with smoking and in accordance with State and Federal law, the Board of Education prohibits smoking, including the use of electronic smoking devices, or other tobacco use in all school buildings, on school property, and at school-sponsored activities.

The District smoking policy shall be prominently posted in each building. The Superintendent of Schools, or his/her designee, shall be responsible for informing individuals smoking that they are in violation of State and Federal law, and may be directed to leave school grounds, or the activity.
