

INTERSCHOLASTIC ATHLETICS

Interscholastic athletics for boys and girls is an integral and desirable part of the District's secondary school educational program. Individual and team sports shall be based upon comprehensive physical education instruction and intramural activities, seeking broad participation from all eligible secondary students. Lifetime or carry-over sports are to be particularly encouraged and supported. Parity in the number and kind of sports activities for girls and boys is a management goal of the District and identified in Gender Equity language in the District Operational Plan.

Student eligibility for participation on interscholastic teams shall include:

1. authorization by the school physician;
2. written parent or guardian consent;
3. endorsement by the school principal based on established rules and various league and State Education Department regulations.

Interscholastic Athletic Coaching Positions

Compensation for interscholastic athletic coaching positions is based on the value of each point which is negotiated under the South Colonie Teachers' Association (SCTA) contract. A summary of positions, points, and compensation rates will be updated on an annual basis on the "Compensated Interscholastic Athletic Coaching Positions" form. This information may be obtained from the Human Resources Department.
