

**STUDENT SMOKING OR
USE OF ELECTRONIC SMOKING DEVICES**

The Board of Education recognizes the health hazards and potential risks associated with smoking and therefore prohibits smoking, including the use of electronic smoking devices, and the use of tobacco and related products by students in school buildings, on school property, or at school-sponsored activities.

Federal and State law prohibits smoking on school property and students violating this policy will be subject to disciplinary penalties. This policy will be prominently posted in each school building.
