

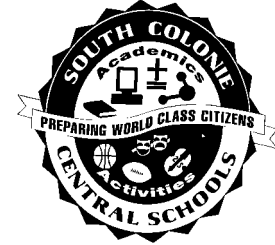

- Attended the Sand Creek Middle School production of Joseph & the Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat. The performances by the students were wonderful and he noted that the students who performed the play eight years ago returned to the school for this year's performance.
- Reminded Board members to review their calendars as there are several concerts and plays at the various schools during the holiday season.
- Reported that, to date, the iCARE student sales and blood drive have raised \$17,000 for Niko DiNovo's medical expenses.
- Reported that the Town of Colonie Advisory Committee Planning Board will be holding a community forum on December 7 at the Forts Ferry School and on December 14 at the Crossings from 6:30 to 8:30 pm. Mr. Kiehle noted that Board members may wish to attend one of the meetings to remind the Planning Board that schools need to be considered when making plans for the community.
- Attended the Toys for Tots Stuff the Bus event at Lisha Kill Middle School. It was a wonderful experience and a great honor to be able to participate.
- Thanked the students at Shaker Road Elementary School for the cards they sent to the Board in appreciation for the new stage curtains at their school.

Mr. Casey

- Attended the play, Joseph & the Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat, at Sand Creek Middle School. He was amazed at the work that Ms. Wickham and the students have done with the performance as well as the sets. He was very pleased with the production and reported that everyone involved did a great job. Mr. Casey also noted that each student who wants to participate in the production gets an opportunity to be involved.

Mr. Sim

- Reported that Mr. Robilotti, Mr. Kachadurian, and the iCARE program are in the process of purchasing crockpots to assist with the current backpack program. Once families have received a crockpot, ingredients for a meal may be sent home in the backpacks each week with a recipe for meals. The program has received donations from Shop Rite and others in the community who have helped out in many ways.


