Mr. Buhner provided a report on the District's annual goals, targets and management statements.

Mr. Backus, Assistant Superintendent for Instruction, reviewed curriculum work funded for completion during the 2016-2017 school year.

**C. Board Committee Reports**

Mr. Ryan, Chairperson, provided a report on the Facilities Committee meeting that was held August 23, 2016.

**5. COMMUNICATIONS****A. Correspondence/Board Activities****Mr. Kiehle**

- The Board expressed its appreciation to Principals, Mr. O’Neil, Mr. Maloney, and all staff in the O&M Department for their good work in preparing for the opening of school.
- Reported that a donation was made to iCARE in honor of CCHS Class of 2016 graduate John Cogan through the “13 Kids Who Care” program sponsored by WNYT Channel 13, the Times Union, and St. Peter’s Health Partners.
- Attended the Opening Day event on September 6. On behalf of the Board, Mr. Kiehle welcomed teachers and thanked them for their efforts. He asked that they continue to invite Board members to school activities as these are positive experiences for all involved.
- Reported on Governor Cuomo signing a bill authorizing school districts to grant the Cold War veterans property tax exemption as well as signing legislation that will require school districts to conduct lead contamination testing in drinking water by October 31.

**Ms. Gigliello**

- Reported that there was a very nice article in the Times Union regarding Mr. Kachadurian and this year’s iCARE initiative which focuses on poverty.

**Mr. Sim**

- Attended the press conference at the High School sponsored by AAA and the District regarding bus safety. The event was very informational and was attended by many community leaders.
- Reported that the GPS installations have been completed and the first training session was held. A second training session will be scheduled.

**Mr. Buhner**

- Reported briefly on Governor Cuomo’s legislation regarding water testing. There are approximately 150 fountains District-wide. We currently have a good system in place but will need to accelerate the schedule to complete the process by the deadline.

**B. Requests to Speak**

Hunter Normandin, a Junior at CCHS and a member of Boy Scout Troop 278, addressed the Board regarding his Eagle Scout project. The project will focus on spreading awareness of school bus safety and stopping for buses when the red lights are flashing. Hunter has been working with Mr. Tunny, the District's Transportation Department, the Village Traffic Safety Committee, Colonie Fire Departments, and the High School to share this message with the public from September 14-21. The flyer for this project will be posted on the District website and sent via SNN District-wide. Banners will be placed on buses that will be parked at the High School and the Community Center and flyers will be distributed to homes in the Village of Colonie.

The Board of Education commended Hunter on his efforts in support of student safety and reducing accidents.
