Junior Conferences

An important part of the Counseling program at Colonie Central High School is the personalized Junior Conference. During our parent/student conference, you will have the opportunity to address any concerns you may have. We will also discuss the following topics:

- Review of your child's transcript and report cards
- Annual review of your child's strengths, interests and goals
- NYS Graduation Requirements
- Post High School Plans including college choices

The high school counselors will be conducting conferences with juniors and their parents beginning January 17, 2017. Conferences typically last approximately 40 minutes and are scheduled during the school day.

In the beginning of December, counselors will be launching a career interest survey through Naviance. As an internet-based program, students are able to access their own account from any computer.
