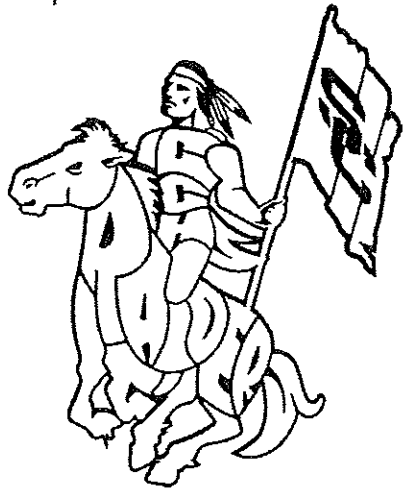


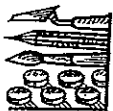

Designed to provide an opportunity for students to pursue activities and projects for either school or personal use.



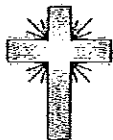
**Best Buddies ~ Mrs. Barry**

Expansion Club is a Christian group. Come every Tuesday at 2:15 in either room 111 or 117 for a chance to be inspired! We usually serve snacks as well.



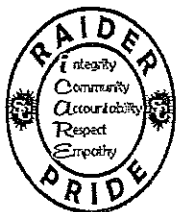
**\*GSA ~ Mrs. Hecht & Mrs. Lukasik**

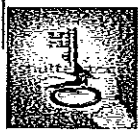


**\*iCare ~ Mr. Kachadurian**
