



## Some Suggested Kindergarten Supplies For the Upcoming School Year

- A backpack ~ big enough to hold stuff
- A lunch box / snack pack
- **Composition Notebook**
- 12-20 glue sticks
- one box of **24 count crayons**  
\*Crayola Crayons do work best and last the longest\*\*
- one box of **washable markers** (8-10 count)
- one package of **Dry Erase Markers**
- one pair of **Scissors**  
\*\*Fiskars Brand Scissors do work best\*\*
- one package (at least a dozen) **#2 pencils**  
\*\*Ticonderoga Pencils do work best and sharpen well\*\*
- A box of **tissues**
- **Ziploc bags** (gallon and sandwich size)

Please note, this is a generic list. Your child's teacher may ask for more specific or different items. But this list may help you shop as items go on sale over the summer.

# First Grade Supply List

- 1 labeled refillable water bottle (*will be returned each night to be washed*)
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 4 boxes of crayons (**24** pack)
- 1 box of broad-line markers (**8** pack)
- 4 packages of **sharpened** plain pencils (Ticonderoga is best ☺)
- 5 **plastic** folders with pockets (plastic hold up the best)

**RED** folder *labeled* with your child's name & **MATH**

**YELLOW** folder *labeled* with your child's name & **READING**

**BLUE** folder *labeled* with your child's name & **SCIENCE/S.S.**

**PURPLE** folder *labeled* with your child's name & **WRITING**

**FOLDER DESIGN OF YOUR CHOICE** *labeled* with your child's name & **GO-HOME FOLDER**

- 1 pair of scissors
- 9 **large** glue sticks
- 1 hard cover composition notebook (**wide ruled**)
- 1 package of dry erase markers (**4** pack, EXPO last the longest)
- 1 clean, old children's sock to be used as a white board eraser
- 1 **PLASTIC** (hard) pencil case (approximately 8x5)
- 3 packages of large erasers
- 1 box of plastic bags- **BOYS**: gallon size **GIRLS**: sandwich size

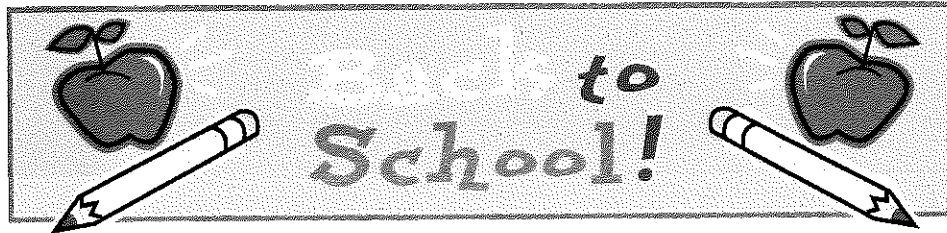

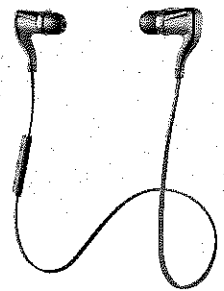
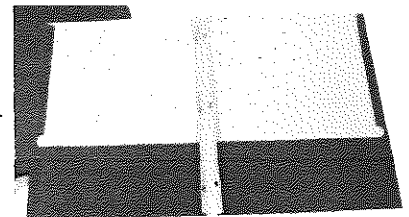
**Common Supply List for Second Grade**

- \_\_\_\_\_ 1- 1-inch binder with plastic folder to go inside,  
**labeled with child's name**
- \_\_\_\_\_ 3 wide ruled marbled composition notebooks,  
**labeled with child's name**
- \_\_\_\_\_ 3 plastic pocket folders, **labeled with child's name**
- \_\_\_\_\_ Crayons, 16 or 24 count
- \_\_\_\_\_ Markers
- \_\_\_\_\_ 36 **sharpened** pencils (Ticonderoga brand are an excellent choice)
- \_\_\_\_\_ 3 **large** glue sticks
- \_\_\_\_\_ 2 large erasers
- \_\_\_\_\_ Scissors, **labeled with child's initials**
- \_\_\_\_\_ 2 large boxes of tissue
- \_\_\_\_\_ 2 dry erase markers
- \_\_\_\_\_ one pair of earbuds in a baggie **labeled with name**

## Common Supply List for Third Grade

Please put your child's name (or initials on smaller items like scissors) on all items.

- \_\_\_ 3 dry erase markers
- \_\_\_ Box of 24 crayons
- \_\_\_ Colored pencils (no magic markers please)
- \_\_\_ 1 pack Ticonderoga brand **SHARPENED** pencils
  
- \_\_\_ Scissors (Fiskar brand work very well)
- \_\_\_ 1 **Large** eraser
- \_\_\_ 1 **Large** glue stick
- \_\_\_ 3 pens (not erasable)
- \_\_\_ 1 cloth zipper pencil pouch (no hard plastic cases please)  
(at least 7 inches x 10 inches)
- \_\_\_ 5 two-pocket folders (pockets across the **bottom**):
  - 1 red labeled **Math**
  - 1 blue labeled **Social Studies/Science**
  - 1 yellow labeled **Reading**
  - 1 purple labeled **Writing**
  - 1 free choice **NOT** labeled
- \_\_\_ 1 green plastic folder with prongs
- \_\_\_ 1 yellow spiral notebook labeled **Reading**
- \_\_\_ 1 marble composition notebook
- \_\_\_ 1 pair ear buds to use with school computers and iPads  
***This will be your child's own personal pair.***
- \_\_\_ 2 boxes of facial tissues



## Common Supply List for Fourth Grade

\*\*\*Please put your child's name (or initials on smaller items like scissors) on all items.\*\*\*

\_\_\_\_\_ Two highlighters

\_\_\_\_\_ Four packages of **sharpened** No. 2 pencils  
(Ticonderoga/Dixon are preferred)

\_\_\_\_\_ 1 package of pencil top erasers

\_\_\_\_\_ 1 package of dry erase markers

\_\_\_\_\_ Crayons (**no more than a 24 pack**)

\_\_\_\_\_ Colored pencils

\_\_\_\_\_ Scissors (Fiskars work well)

\_\_\_\_\_ School glue

- Boys - 2 bottles of liquid glue
- Girls - one 3-pack of glue sticks

\_\_\_\_\_ Two marble composition notebooks (both labeled with your child's name-one labeled **READING**, one labeled **WRITING**)

\_\_\_\_\_ 1 vinyl folder of each color - **RED, BLUE, GREEN** and **YELLOW**

\_\_\_\_\_ 1 box of tissues

\_\_\_\_\_ \$2.00 in an envelope for the student assignment books. Please put your child's name and "**Student Agenda**" on the outside of the envelope. This money should be sent in with your child to school on the first day.

\_\_\_\_\_ \$20 activity fee in an envelope, labeled with your child's name and "Activity Fee." This will be used to cover the cost of field trips, presentations, and other activities and crafts throughout the year.
