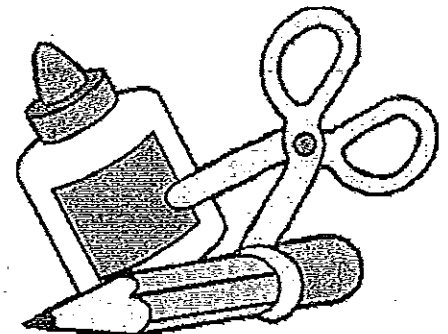
Supply List 2017 -2018

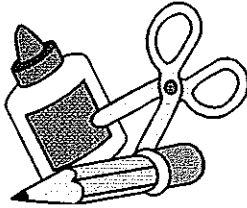

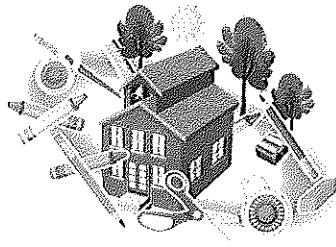

Please write your name on the inside cover of each notebook.
- **1 spiral notebook with at least 100 pages**
Please label with your name and "Math".
