## **A Letter from Superintendent Jonathan W. Buhner**

October 17, 2016

Dear Saddlewood Elementary Parents and Staff Members,

The purpose of this letter is to inform you that on Monday, October 17, 2016 the District received preliminary results of water quality testing which is being performed in all of our schools in accordance with legislation signed by Governor Cuomo on September 6, 2016. The new law requires all New York State public schools to test all water sources for lead contamination. The State Department of Health and the State Education Department have established an action level threshold of 15 parts per billion or .015 mg/L. The water sources that test above this level must be immediately taken out of service and corrective action must be taken.

It is important to note that South Colonie Central School District has followed its own water testing protocols initiated approximately 15 years ago, long before the state initiated this recent legislation. Since then, South Colonie's Operations and Maintenance staff members have conducted random samplings of drinking water sources at all sites across the District. Over the years the results have shown that levels have consistently tested below the actionable level set by the state.


All of the water testing results for Saddlewood Elementary School have been received by District officials. All potable water sources at Saddlewood Elementary School were tested over the last few weeks including drinking fountains, sink faucets in classrooms, restrooms, and faucets in the kitchen/cafeteria areas. Of the 55 samples which were received back from testing, none were above the allowable .015 mg/L or 15 parts per billion as per the new regulations.

If any future results show actionable levels of lead in potable water sources, the District will replace or remediate the affected water pipes and fixtures.

Please be assured that we will continue to take the necessary steps to ensure the quality of drinking water throughout our District meets these new state regulations. We will keep you informed as we continue to receive the results of the ongoing water testing at all of our schools.
