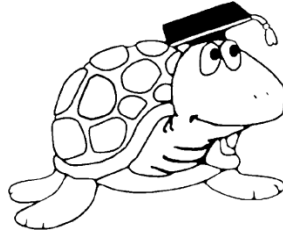


Shaker Road Kindergarten Supply List



For kindergarten your child will be asked to bring the items listed below.

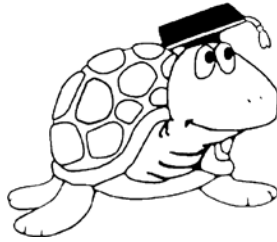
Please bring supplies with you on Kindergarten Bus Orientation Day in September!

There is no need to label items with your child's name unless otherwise noted.

- 1 backpack (big enough to fit a folder, lunch box, snack, and projects)
- 2 marble composition notebooks (*Please label with your child's name.*)
- 1 bottle of regular, white Elmer's glue
- 2 packages of Ticonderoga® #2 pencils
- 6 giant Elmer's glue sticks
- 1 two-pocket (home/school) folder (*Please label with your child's name.*)
- 1 plastic, two-pocket folder (horizontal pockets)
- 1 package of thin, black Expo® Dry Erase markers
- 2 packages of 8 or 10 count thick Crayola® Markers (Classic Colors please)
- 2 boxes of 24 Crayola® crayons
- Fiskars® scissors (5" child's blunt tip)
- 1 pack of white 3"x5" index cards
- 1 box of tissues
- 1 pack of Post-It notes
- 1 soft beach towel (for rest time) (*Please write your child's name on the tag.*)

Shaker Road First Grade Supply List



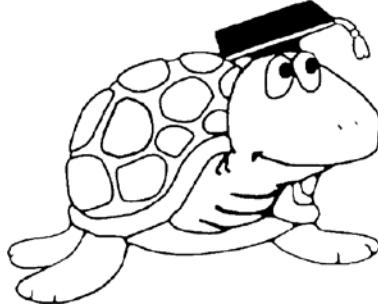
For the first grade your child will be asked to bring the items listed below.

- 12 (or more) glue sticks—We do lots of projects!
- 1 box of crayons
- 1 box of washable markers
- 1 box of low-odor dry erase markers
- 3 boxes of SHARPENED Ticonderoga pencils
- 1 large pencil eraser
- 1 two-pocket folder with fasteners (blue)
--no characters or designs please
- 2 plastic two-pocket folders (any color or design)
- 1 composition book
- 1 box of tissues
- 1 old but clean sock
- gallon-size Ziploc bags - boys
- baby wipe container or refill pack - girls
- headphones* (Please, no earbuds.)

For the second grade your child will be asked to bring the items listed below.

- 1 wide-ruled composition notebook (with name labeled on it)
- 2 packs of washable markers (no skinny/thin markers)
- 1 package of Crayola Twistable Crayons (24 count)
- 1 large box of tissues
- 3 strong plastic folders (with name labeled on it)
- 8 glue sticks and 1 small bottle of "wet" school glue
- 3 boxes of eraser tips and 1 large eraser
- 3 pop-up dispensers of antibacterial Wet Ones
- Ziploc bags: quart size - girls/gallon size - boys
- 4 boxes of **SHARPENED** pencils (Ticonderoga ONLY, and please **SHARPEN!**)
- 1 package of highlighting markers
- Dry erase Expo "Chisel" tip markers - boys
- Post-It Notes 3"x3" - girls
- 1 set of headphones (Please, **NO EARBUDS.**)

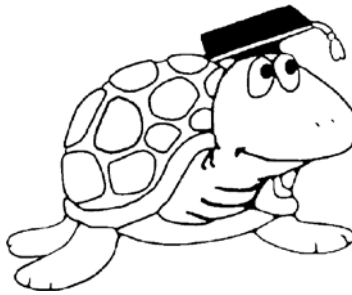

For the third grade your child will be asked to bring the items listed below.

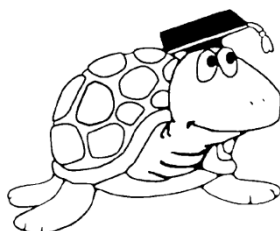
- Composition Notebooks - 2
